

## Burdens related to Europe (week of 18 January 2026)

### 1) First Lord's table meeting in Lille, France (24-25 January)

On 24-25 January a new lampstand will be raised up in Lille, France. This will be the third new local church raised up in France since the gospel trips related to the summer Olympics held in Paris in 2024. **An announcement and invitation letter with instructions on registering is [available here](#).** Please pray that the Lord will continue to build up His testimony in Lille and in other cities in France.

Several students and a teacher of Chinese language have been contacted and are very open. At the end of January a gospel team from the FTTA will spend time in Gdansk. Please pray:

- That the Lord will reach more seeking ones in Gdansk through the gospel trip and that two more families will move to Gdansk and live near the university.
- That the Lord will raise up a lampstand in Gdansk to spread His testimony in Poland.
